## Around the World in 5 Days

Take a voyage to mysterious civilizations. Meet the Aztecs, Incas, and Mayas. Really cool guys, as long as they pick someone else to sacrifice. Make Inca expression masks, learn about the history of Aztec chocolate, and sample it along with other chocolates of the world. Take a chuck wagon journey to the Wild West, pan for gold, and cook up some "cowboy" cuisine. Combine traditional Native American culture and modern math concepts to explore the geometric shapes of a dream catcher. Tell your own story with Aboriginal dot art and learn how to speak like an "Aussie." Build and play the African logical game of Mancala and hear fascinating stories about smuggling diamonds out of the Namibian desert. How would you look as a Maasai warrior? Find out as you create Maasai necklaces and try on their traditional attire. Then take a journey to the Far East to learn about the daily life of Sumo wrestlers and the true story behind dragons. Replicate a few exciting Chinese inventions. Journey on to Europe to learn about Michelangelo's paintings, try to recreate ceiling art by painting under the table, and mix candy watercolors to modify Leonardo da Vinci's portrait into a "Mona You!"

## Ocean Explorers & Wildlife Safaris

Become an ocean explorer by performing unusual and exciting science experiments. Discover layers of the ocean zone, look at sand under the microscope, make waves, and simulate tornadoes. Discover why fish are unsinkable and why whales do not freeze in cold waters. Explore a shark's sense of smell and perform ocean surgery by dissecting a shark. Discover what makes an eel electric and how science can help in case of an oil spill.

Then take a journey into the world of wild life. Discover which animal is the most intelligent and which is the only mammal that can fly. Explore some startling defenses and extreme adaptations that help animals survive. Learn the languages of dogs and bees to get your point across. See the surprising things an owl ate for breakfast. Build an insect habitat and take home some creepy crawlers if you dare.
